


Reaching out to the Community

Envision helps individuals, families, and couples feel empowered by providing therapeutic counselling and support, in-home services, groups, workshops, and education.

We are a Welcoming Place

Envision believes in client-centered support. You may come to us with questions. You might even be afraid. We will create a safe and welcoming place for you to explore your questions, options, and needs. We can help with:

Therapeutic Counselling and Support

We provide free and confidential counselling without a referral to individuals in Southeast Saskatchewan. We can help with counselling for adults, teens, children, couples, and families.

Family Support Services

We provide intensive in-home support on a short term basis to families and their children as contracted by the Ministry of Social Services, Mental Health's Child & Youth Program, and community referrals. We also accept voluntary referrals.

Groups, Workshops, and Education

We offer educational presentations to agencies, organizations, groups, schools, or businesses. Participants may sign up for workshops and support groups that will improve self-worth by relating to others with similar experiences.

Individual Counselling

We help individuals whose lives have been impacted by emotional, physical, verbal, or sexual abuse.

We welcome individuals seeking support in the following areas:

- Survivors of Childhood Abuse
- Sexual Assault
- Stalking/Harassment
- Parent/Teen Conflict
- Relationship Breakdown
- Communication in Relationships
- Abusive Relationships
- Exposure to trafficking or sexual exploitation
- Secondary Survivor Support

Our focus is your happiness and well-being. We will work together to help you feel better.

Family Counselling

Your family may suddenly experience an event or situation that is overwhelming or traumatic. These challenges may include marital breakdown, separation or divorce, parent and child disputes, blended family struggles, loss and grief, and more.

We provide a non-judgemental place where a counsellor will listen, offer support, and help develop a plan to move forward.

Through therapeutic counselling for couples and families, we can help to stabilize your family and strengthen your relationships with each other.

Children, Youth, and Teen Counselling

Envision offers help to children, youth, and teens (aged 5 to 18) who have been exposed to violence. Many of these children feel overwhelmed and need someone to talk to in a safe and supportive environment. Parent support is available through this program as well.

We also work in partnership with schools to provide counselling, support, and groups.

Family Support

The emphasis of the intensive in-home support services provided by our Family Support Workers is on maintaining the family unit with new skills and tools that strengthen the entire family.

We believe that when families are given support, education, and resources, they are able to recognize and build on their strengths.



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
