Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Where does my donation go?

Directly to Envision clients and programming which include community awareness and education, transportation for a rural client who is isolated and unable to attend their sessions without assistance, personal items for individuals fleeing domestic violence, or overnight hotel for a family in transition.

Q. Can I specify how my donation is spent?

A. YES! If you would like to direct your donation to a specific area or program, let us know and we will ensure that your donation is utilized towards the location of your choice.

Q. What is the privacy policy for Envision?

A. In order to process your donation, we require your name and address (for charitable receipt.) We respect your privacy and will not trade, sell or disclose your information to any third party. If you would like recognition, we will post your name to our website and social media outlets.

Q. Can I get a tax receipt?
