

RBC Donates to Envision

Staff members at the RBC branch in Estevan have been busy the last few months, through RBC Day of Service Grant activities.

An RBC Day of Service Grant is a \$1,000 allocation for charitable organizations that provide a direct community service. To qualify for the grant, the organization must meet several criteria.

It must have at least six volunteers participating in the activity, three of which must be RBC employees. A volunteer activity must be completed as a team within two months of the start of National Volunteer Week on April 12.

The activity must also be at least three consecutive hours long, completed outside of business hours, and be in direct service to the benefiting organization.

Ten charities each received \$1,000. They were: the Salvation Army, the Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation, the Estevan Public Library, the Envision Counselling and Support Centre, the Estevan Family Resource Centre, the Estevan Humane Society, the MS Society, St. Joseph's Hospital, the Souris Valley Theatre and the Canadian Cancer Society.
