As part of their preparations for their 25th anniversary luncheon, Envision Counselling has received a major donation of \$10,000 from the Microtel Inn and Suites in Estevan. The donation is part of a program that the Microtel has put together for their workers, but there's more to it than just a program.

"Our core values really meshed together between Envision Counselling and us," says Lorna Knoll, Regional General Manager for the Microtel. "It's really a great combination to be partners with."

It's the second year in a row they've sent their yearly contribution to Envision as part of a yearly donation they make that comes as part of the revenue made from both Estevan and Weyburn's locations. Staff at both locations were consulted as to where

the donation should be made, whether they should split it between different places in each city or make one large donation to one spot that benefits both.

"We contribute daily and monthly through hotel revenues through the property and it all goes into one master fund, and then we advocate for our charity of choice, and after discussion with the staff, last year we chose Envision for 2017 and 2018 so this donation is a collaboration from both locations."

It's a move that helps Envision ahead of their luncheon as none other than Theo Fleury, and with less than two months to go for their celebration, they aren't too far away. According to Tania Andrist, Resource Development Co-ordinator with Envision says they couldn't have a better speaker coming.

"We knew that his story and his connections to the hockey community and the community of southeast Saskatchewan at large were so closely aligned with what we are doing within our community. It was just a dream. We wanted to shoot for the stars, who's the biggest celebrity and how can we connect that to our 25th anniversary."
