

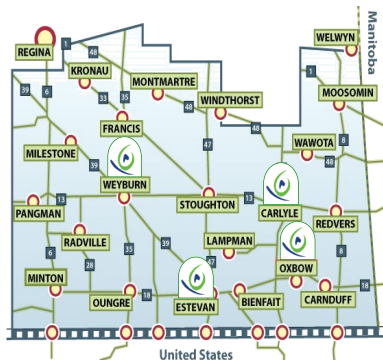
Family Support

This program is offered free of charge. Family Support Workers help families with time-limited goals to assist building new skills and increase their family's strengths. In the comfort of the family's own home, Family Support Workers provide non-judgmental support for common family struggles. Flexible appointment times including evenings and weekends are also available in this program.

Envision helps individuals, families and couples feel empowered by providing therapeutic counselling and support, in-home services, groups, workshops and education.

We are a Welcoming Place

Envision believes in client-centered support. We create a safe and welcoming place for individuals to explore any questions they may have regarding their current needs or future options.

We Can Help With:

Therapeutic Counselling and Support

We provide free and confidential counselling without a referral to individuals in Southeast Saskatchewan. We can help with counselling for adults, seniors, teens, children, couples and families.

Family Support Services

We provide intensive in-home support on a short term basis to families and their children as contracted by the Ministry of Social Services, Mental Health's Child & Youth Program and community referrals. We also accept voluntary referrals.

Groups, Workshops and Education

We offer educational presentations to agencies, organizations, groups, schools or businesses. Participants may sign up for workshops and support groups that will improve self-worth by relating to others with similar experiences.

We welcome people seeking support in many areas including:

- Survivors of Childhood Abuse
- Sexual Assault
- Stalking/Harassment
- Parent/Teen Conflict
- Relationship Breakdown
- Communication in Relationships
- Abusive Relationships
- Exposure to trafficking or exploitation
- Secondary Survivor Support

We provide a non-judgemental place where a counsellor will listen, offer support and help develop a plan to move forward.

Family Counselling

Experiencing a sudden event or situation that is overwhelming or traumatic can often be challenging to deal with. These events may include grief and loss, marital breakdown, separation or divorce, parent and child disputes, blended family struggles and more.

Children, Youth and Teen Counselling

Envision offers help to children, youth and teens (aged 5 to 18) who have been exposed to violence. Many of these children feel overwhelmed and need someone to talk to in a safe and supportive environment. Our counselling helps bridge the gap between youth and caregivers.

Individual Counselling

We help individuals whose lives have been impacted by emotional, physical, verbal or sexual abuse. We offer this support in-person, over the phone, and virtually.

Employee Assistance Program/ Fee For Service (EAP/FFS)

EAP Counselling is designed for those who do not meet the mandate of other Envision programs. This is covered by employer insurance when available or is offered for a reasonable fee (FFS). This program offers flexible appointment times including evenings and weekends.

Rapid Access Counselling

Rapid Access Counselling is a free, immediate, accessible form of brief counselling. This service is offered offsite in Estevan, Weyburn and Oxbow. Sessions can be booked at counsellingconnectsask.ca or through reception by calling the Estevan or Weyburn office. Full details, including dates and times, can be found on our website.
